Specific course requirements and group arrangements

- Each semester you are required to take courses totalling **30 ECTS** points (some obligatory, some elective, some variable), and **you are responsible** for getting all required credits: in the first semester the choice is only related to INDUCTION (60h) courses
- ECTS points are assigned to each course to mark the difficulty of the course and the effort that needs to be taken to complete it. ECTS system is designed to ensure compatibility with partner institutions (collaborating across Europe through Erasmus+ program) regarding possible mobilities. NB: **Any mobility decisions require thoughtful consideration and consultation with the MA supervisor;**
- Each student is obliged to take an **obligatory safety training** and a **library training** at UO;
- Students choose their year **representative** – a person responsible for contacting the tutor, the Dean and other relevant bodies in case it is necessary to consult over issues related to program arrangements; students are also free choose a vice-representative, a treasurer and leaders of the sub-groups and cooperate with student bodies: Samorząd Studencki UO (Student Self-Government of Opole University), Rada Studentów Wydziału Filologicznego (Student Council of Philology Faculty).
